SHORT HISTORY: BozART opened its doors across from McGuffey in 1995. The gallery moved to the downtown mall in 1997, became incorporated and ran a successful business until it finally closed its doors in June 2014. The members then decided to remain as a group, with a steering committee. They wanted to continue to display and sell their art so the steering committee found venues in and near Charlottesville.

NOW: We meet monthly: discuss upcoming shows, new ideas for the group, share something we learned AND we drop off or pick up artwork for our shows. The steering committee meets 2-3 times a year to discuss ideas and talk about potential shows. We have at least one gathering i.e., Xmas or vineyard.

BOZART PROVIDES

- Opportunities to exhibit artwork in Central Virginia;
- Each show has a facilitating member who emails details of the show: # of entries per member, reception info., commission on sales, etc.;
- Receive a show list for the year with: dates, address, facilitator + helpers, commission, etc.;
- Publicity is currently through website, facebook, e-newsletter, a brochure with each member + image and/or a postcard/e-postcard.
- A website page for each member on which you provide information about yourself and your art and you can upload 6 - 16 jpg's of artworks. To see examples, refer to: www.bozartgallery.com;
- Judi Ely, Membership Committee chair will communicate with new applicants; answer questions; present the application for judging; notify you the status of the application.
- Minutes emailed from monthly meetings; member lists, calendar, more

AS A MEMBER of the BozART FAC, you should:

- participate in some of the yearly shows and/or provide food at a reception;
- attend a monthly meeting, voice interests/concerns, suggest venues, vote on new members and share your ideas;
- facilitate or be a helper with installation/deinstallation for at least one exhibit;
- keep track of the shows and your artwork. Ask questions of the show facilitator and pick up your artwork at the meeting or in a timely manner;
- sign your artwork, make sure it is ready to hang with wire attached to back. Attach a card/paper with title/price/artist name on back of your art.
- take an interest in creating new artwork.
- Share your talent to help with group function: hang shows, type labels, design postcard, maintain member or venue lists, update website, etc.

APPLICATION: Complete and **provide 4-6 jpgs of your artwork or your website**. The images should be **created within the last 3 years**. The members review the application and artwork and make a decision. The Membership Committee chair, Judi Ely, will contact you with the group's decision.
